


LCB DUTIES



- How comfortable a bicyclist may feel on a particular roadway









PED/BIKE SAFETY STUDY






Pedestrian: Red areas represent ~ 5 to 7 times greater crash density than the green areas

<u>Bicycle:</u> ~6 to 8 times greater crash density

PED/BIKE SAFETY STUDY

Hot spots and Corridors

oIntersection with highest crash density = Military Trail @ Forest Hill Blvd.

Corridor with highest crash density = Military Trail from Melaleuca Lane to Community Drive


