Beginning at 9 p.m. Thursday night, June 2, the intersection of State Road (SR) 710 and President Barack Obama Highway will undergo a full closure through approximately 7 a.m. Monday, June 6, for drainage work. Motorists heading northbound and southbound on President Barack Obama Highway will be detoured via W. 7th Street and Avenue G. Truck traffic on SR 710 will have access to the Port of Palm Beach during this time via a temporary roadway located to the north and south of the intersection closure. (see below)

The contractor will also work on the following activities in May:

- Installation of new drainage and water lines will continue along Avenue I through approximately **May 2016**. Avenue I, between SR 710 and 9th Street, will remain closed during this time. Motorists may detour via Avenue J and Avenue H to 9th Street, to access Avenue I north of SR 710.
- **Perimeter wall construction to begin, lasting through approximately August 2016.** Work will be performed daily, Monday through Friday, and is expected to start on the south side of SR 710 in the Right-of-Way just east of Avenue P. Please contact the project team directly for updates on the wall construction schedule and progress as needed.
