Dear Mr. Uhren:

Pursuant to Title 23 and Title 49, the Florida Department of Transportation requests your processing and approval of the attached amendment to the FY 2020/21 – 2024/25 Transportation Improvement Program. This amendment is required because the project cost has increased by more than 20% AND \$2 million and needs to be reflected in the TIP. The proposed alternative for the subject project has been identified as Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI). The project limits and design costs have been changed to accommodate the proposed DDI, capturing the work on the approaches to I-95 and its ramps, which includes design services for reconstruction of seven bridges. The limits are as follows:

- I-95 from North of Hypoluxo Road to South of 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue S.
- Lantana Road from High Ridge Road to Andrew Redding Road.
- On Ramp from EB Lantana Road to SB I-95.
- Off ramp From NB I-95 to EB Lantana Road.
- Off ramp from SB I-95 to WB Lantana Road.
- On Ramp WB Lantana Road to NB I-95.

This Transportation Improvement Program Amendment should be consistent with the Adopted Long-Range Transportation Plan, as well as part of the FDOT vision of achieving a fatality free transportation system. The adopted TIP remains financially constrained. A State Transportation Improvement Program (STIP) amendment is required. The TIP amendment is for the following:

Dear Mr. Uhren:

Pursuant to Part IV – Chapter 5: Statewide and Local Transportation Improvement Programs (STIP and TIP) of the Work Program Instructions, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) requests your processing and approval of the attached amendment to the FY 2020/21 – 2024/25 Transportation Improvement Program. This amendment is required because the project cost has increased by more than 20% AND \$2 million and needs to be reflected in the TIP. This cost increase was due to an increase in the project length and pay items. This project included the addition of auxiliary lanes on both intersections. In order to include the auxiliary lanes added south of Okeelanta and north of CR-827 for each respective intersections, the limits of the project were extended. Additional pay items were included: Geogrid reinforcement was recommended to be added in this to this project, which increased the earthwork quantities by a significant amount. Seed and mulch which was previously provided for the swale and the median was also changed to Sod. Guardrail in areas where we were providing nested guardrail was replaced instead of reset.

This Transportation Improvement Program Amendment should be consistent with the Adopted Long-Range Transportation Plan. The adopted TIP remains financially constrained. The TIP amendment is as follows:

The South Florida Regional Transportation Authority (SFRTA) is constructing a new Northern Layover and Light Maintenance Facility (NLMF) in Palm Beach County that will both improve the efficiency of current Tri-Rail operations and facilitate further system enhancements and expansion. The NLMF will add greatly needed train storage capacity for the existing Tri-Rail system as well as the planned expansion to the Florida East Coast (FEC) railway corridor. SFRTA is currently in the procurement phase of the NLMF project, and is expected to award a Design Build Contract by mid-year 2021.

Recently the City of Delray Beach declined the use of federal funds for the replacement purchase of Trolley Vehicles. SFRTA would like to request the re-purposing of FM 438400-1 Delray Beach Trolleys – Replacement Purchase Vehicles/Equipment funds in the amount \$860,000 to FM 429767-1 NLMF project, to allow for additional improvements needed for the facility. The project is identified as a priority in SFRTA's Transit Development Plan (TDP), in the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (TPA) list of priority projects FY22 - FY26 and 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP).

SFRTA thanks the Palm Beach TPA for its on-going support for the NLMF. Please let me know if you have any questions or would like to discuss further.

### **TPA RESOLUTION 2021-05**

# A RESOLUTION APPROVING AMENDMENT 4 TO THE FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2021-2025 TRANSPORTATION IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (TIP)

WHEREAS, the Palm Beach Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) doing business as the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency (TPA), is the designated and duly constituted body responsible for the urban transportation planning process for Palm Beach County; and

WHEREAS, both 23 U.S.C. §134(j) and 23 CFR §450.326 mandate that the TPA develop and update a TIP at least every 4 years that reflects the investment priorities of the TPA's adopted Long Range Transportation Plan and covers a period of no less than 4 years; and

WHEREAS, the TPA's FY 21-25 TIP is a staged program encompassing a five-year period and including all regionally significant transportation improvements to all modes of travel in Palm Beach County as well as locally funded transportation improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, the TIP identifies projects for maintaining and improving the transportation system funded by federal, state and local sources in order to assist local governments with their transportation planning efforts; and

WHEREAS, the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) has requested approval of two (2) project modifications to the FY 21-25 TIP and the City of Delray Beach has requested a project deletion with funding repurposes to the TPA's next transit priority as shown in Exhibit A attached; and

WHEREAS, the TPA's Bicycle, Trailway and Pedestrian Advisory Committee recommended design modifications to the bicycle facilities proposed for the I-95 at Lantana Road interchange project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PALM BEACH MPO, d/b/a PALM BEACH TRANSPORTATION PLANNING AGENCY, THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The foregoing recitals are hereby adopted and declared to be true and correct and are incorporated herein.

**SECTION 2.** The TPA Governing Board hereby approves Amendment 4 to the FY 21-25 Transportation Improvement Program, attached hereto as "Exhibit A" and by this reference incorporated herein, and authorizes its Executive Director to execute any and all corresponding

documents to memorialize this approval. This amendment does not affect or re-adopt any other provision of the TIP.

**SECTION 3.** The TPA Governing Board asks FDOT modify the design for I-95 at the Lantana Road Interchange to include continuous shared-use paths or wider sidewalks in both directions on Lantana Road within the project limits even if it means exclusion of the proposed on-street bicycle facilities within the project limits.

**SECTION 4.** This Resolution shall take effect upon adoption.

The foregoing Resolution was offered by Commissioner Maria Marino who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilman Michael Napoleone, and upon being put to a vote, the motion passed. The Chair thereupon declared the Resolution duly adopted this 15th day of April 2021.
