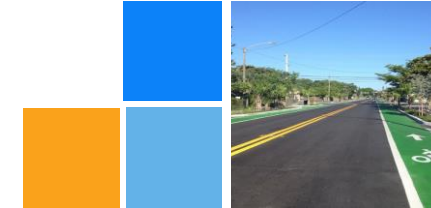

Frequently Asked Questions

- Why multiple project lists?
 - Different funding source for each list
- How are the projects ranked?
 - Points based on the Goals, Objectives and Values in the adopted 2040 LRTP
- Why do we show funding in the tables?
 - To convey total project cost, schedule and funding need
- If a project is on a list, is funding guaranteed?
 - Unfortunately not. The priority list is guidance to FDOT for the FY 19-23 work program



MPO Major Projects

- MPO Role is to prioritize projects in the LRTP
- Proposed Addition:
 - Okeechobee Boulevard Multimodal Corridor Study (including a connection south to the Mall at Wellington Green), with the potential for premium transit service
- Why is this project proposed?
 - 16 projects in the LRTP are already MPO priorities or programmed by others
 - Next 8 projects in order by LRTP project score are shown on following slide along with MPO staff recommendation for each

Yamato Rd Tri-Rail Station in Boca Raton Park and Ride Expansion	\$11.0	Do Not Prioritize – Construct second Tri-Rail station in Boca Raton first
I-95: WPB to Jupiter Express Bus	\$4.6	Do Not Prioritize – Two parallel N/S transit corridors prioritized
Okeechobee Blvd: SR 7 to US 1 Express Bus & Multimodal Corridor Improvements	TBD	Recommended inclusion on Priority List
Glades Area – SR 80 at Hooker Hwy New Intermodal Center	\$19.3	Do Not Prioritize – Wait for SR 80 Corridor Plan, Palm Tran RPM
Hooker Hwy: SR 715 to SR 80 Widen to 4L	\$11.4	Do Not Prioritize – Traffic Counts do not warrant project



- Add SR 80 Street Lighting: SR 15 to CR 880
 - Estimated Capital Cost of \$5.5M
 - Will require favorable lighting justification study by FDOT
 - County Vice Mayor requested project
 - County Engineering letter committing to fund O&M

Local Initiatives

- Local applications submitted annually
- 8 Projects submitted, 7 deemed eligible:
 - 36th Street Buffered bicycle lanes (West Palm Beach)
 - Lindell Boulevard sidewalks and cycle tracks (Delray Beach)
 - Indiantown Road bicycle lanes and multiuse paths (Jupiter)
 - Palm Tran bus shelter replacements
 - 36th Street Bridge/Lighting (West Palm Beach)
 - Barwick Road sidewalks and cycle tracks (Delray Beach)
 - Brandt Bridge Connector sidewalks and cycle tracks (Delray Beach)
- Additional Public Outreach required for Lindell Blvd & Brandt Bridge Connector





Transportation Alternatives

- Non-motorized infrastructure projects
- Local applications submitted annually
- 6 Projects submitted, 4 recommended for funding:
 - Northmore neighborhood pedestrian improvements (West Palm Beach)
 - Belvedere Heights neighborhood pedestrian improvements (Westgate CRA/Palm Beach County)
 - Anchorage Drive bicycle lanes (North Palm Beach)
 - FPL Pathway LED lighting (Royal Palm Beach, partial funding)
- Additional Public Outreach required for Northmore neighborhood, Belvedere Heights and Anchorage Drive
