HEALTH IMPACT ASSESSMENT

A Health Impact Assessment (HIA) is a process that analyzes and quantifies how a policy or investment influences people's health. The goals are:

- Improve access to jobs and education
- Improve access to health and community service
- Improve safety for pedestrians and bicyclists
- Support development / redevelopment along the corridor

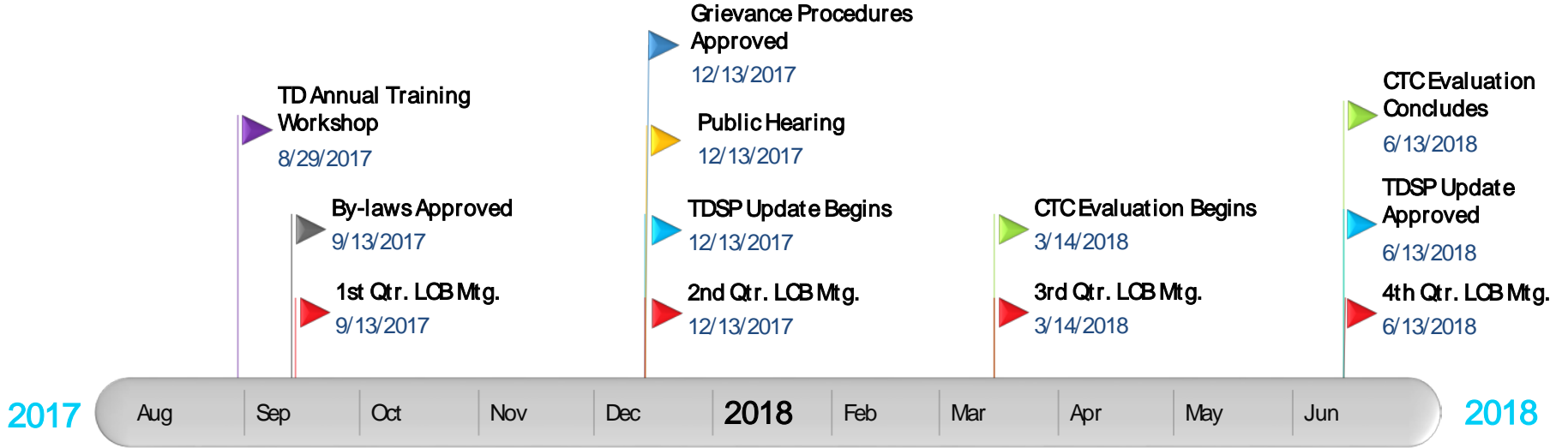
