- A. MOTION TO ELECT OFFICERS for the 2019 Calendar Year  
The By-Laws stipulate that the committee shall, by majority vote of the voting members present, elect a Chair and a Vice Chair annually at the last regularly scheduled meeting of the calendar year. The newly elected officers shall take office at the first regularly scheduled meeting of the following calendar year and shall serve for one year. Mr. Glen Harvie is the current Chair and Dr. Myron Uman is the current Vice Chair.
- B. MOTION TO RECOMMEND APPROVAL of the Priority Projects List Amendment  
Palm Tran is requesting the transfer of \$2,500,000 in Local Initiatives funds (SU) from the Route 43 and Route 62 Transit Signal Prioritization project (FM 4317331) to instead be used on Fare Technology Interoperability (FM 4317611). The Palm Tran letter and Priority Project List amendment are attached.
- C. MOTION TO RECOMMEND APPROVAL of the Florida Department of Transportation FY 20-24 Draft Tentative Work Program  
Pursuant to §339.135(4)(d), F.S., the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) shall present the work program to the TPA "to determine the necessity

of making any changes to projects included or to be included in the district work program and to hear requests for new projects to be added to, or existing projects to be deleted from, the district work program.” To facilitate the TPA review, the documents listed below are attached.

#### B. Annual Obligations Report for FY 18

The TPA is obligated by 23 CFR 450.334 to create an annual report comparing the Federal funds requested in the Transportation Improvement Plan (TIP) with the Federal funds obligated in the previous year. TPA staff will review the attached report.

#### C. I-95 Managed Lanes Master Plan Update

FDOT will provide an update for the Managed Lanes Master Plan for I-95 from Linton Blvd to Indiantown Road, including the draft location of access points.

#### D. Updates to Local Initiatives (LI) and Transportation Alternatives (TA) Program Guidelines and Scoring System

The LI and TA programs provide an annual, competitive application process to prioritize federal funds towards community identified projects that accomplish TPA goals and objectives.
