Bicycle-Trailways-Pedestrian Advisory Committee Liaison's Report - October 4, 2018

1. **ADA Transition Plan workshop:** The Palm Beach TPA is required by federal agencies to sign assurances that all recipients of federal funds allocated by the TPA have ADA transition plans in place. The Palm Beach TPA will host a half-day workshop on October 11, with training by Dean Perkins, Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) ADA Coordinator. 5. **FDOT Projects Scheduled for Design & Scoping:** FDOT has provided an updated spreadsheet that serves as a tracker for FDOT projects heading into the design phase. The content is centered around key dates within the FDOT schedule that serve as opportunities for TPA committee members to provide input and comments. The spreadsheet is a 3-12 month preview and will be updated quarterly.
6. **MPOAC Institute Training:** The TPA held a local MPOAC Institute Training for Governing Board members in May, which provided an understanding of transportation decision-making, including the key role they play in the process as well as provide members with the knowledge and tools necessary to engage in the metropolitan planning process.
