



## Executive Director's Report - December 12, 2019

1. **Transition Update:** The TPA moved into its new office and meeting space at 301 Datura Street on November 18, 2019. Please note our new address and phone number below. The TPA also formally notified Palm Beach County that we vacated the County space as of November 22, 2019. The TPA's agreement with Palm Beach County continues through January 31, 2020 to allow time for final reconciliation of all County funds that were advanced to the TPA and then repaid from TPA planning grant reimbursements.
2. **Vision Zero Workshop:** Pursuant to its Vision Zero Action Plan, the TPA is hosting a Vision Zero Workshop on Friday, December 13 from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the new TPA office located at 301 Datura Street, West Palm Beach, FL 33401. The purpose of the workshop is to assist local governments in Palm Beach County with endorsement and implementation of Vision Zero, a commitment toward zero traffic-related fatalities and serious injuries. 3. **FTA-FHWA Transit Peer Exchange:** FTA, FHWA, TPA, Palm Tran, Valley Metro (Phoenix, AZ), Capital Metro (Austin, TX), and leadership staff from Florida Urban Transit Agencies will convene for a 1-day peer exchange on Friday, January 17 from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the new TPA office located at 301 Datura St, West Palm Beach, FL 33401. TPA Governing Board Members are encouraged to participate. Following the peer exchange, a summary document will be created and shared on the TPA's website.
4. **January Meetings:** As a reminder, there is no Governing Board meeting in January. The next Board meeting will be held on Thursday, February 20, 2020 at the new TPA office located at 301 Datura Street, West Palm Beach, FL 33401.
