2. **Vision Zero Workshop:** The TPA is hosting a Vision Zero Workshop on Friday, December 13 from 9 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the new TPA office located at 301 Datura Street, West Palm Beach, FL 33401. The purpose of the workshop is to assist local governments in Palm Beach County with endorsement and implementation of Vision Zero, a commitment toward the target of zero traffic-related fatalities and serious injuries.
