3. **Vision Zero Community Safety Fair:** FDOT will be hosting a FREE community safety event at the West Palm Beach Waterfront, along Flagler Drive and Clematis Street, on February 9 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Activities scheduled during this safety fair include a Children's Bike Rodeo hosted by FDOT, Roll-Over Vehicle Demonstrations hosted by FHP, free bike helmets & fittings and Safety Tips for children & adults.

No formal presentation will be made, design plans and project information will be on display, and staff will be available to discuss the project, answer questions and address individual concerns.
