## Bicycle-Trailways-Pedestrian Advisory Committee Liaison's Report - July 11, 2019

1. **July TPA Governing Board Meeting:** The next TPA Governing Board Meeting will be held on Thursday, July 18 at 9:00 a.m. at the West Palm Beach Lake Pavilion, 101 S Flagler Drive, West Palm Beach, FL 33401.
2. **August Meetings:** As a reminder, there are no Governing Board or advisory committee meetings held in August. The next BTPAC meeting will be held on Thursday, September 5, 2019. However, while there will be no regularly-scheduled BTPAC meeting in August, there will be a Special Meeting held on August 8, 2019 for the Transportation Alternatives (TA) Scoring Workshop where committee members will finalize scoring sheet items for the 2020 TA cycle. This meeting will follow PPP procedures and is open for the public to attend.
3. **Safe Routes to School (SRTS) Workshop and Grant Application Window:** The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will be holding a SRTS Grant Application Workshop on August 13, 2019 from 9:00 AM to 12:00 PM in the FDOT District 4 auditorium located at 3400 W Commercial Blvd, Fort Lauderdale, FL 33309. Workshop attendance is mandatory for all applicants. The application period will be open September 1, 2019 through December 31, 2019.
