- A. MOTION TO RECOMMEND APPROVAL of the Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) FY 21-25 Draft Tentative Work Program

Pursuant to Section 339.135(4)(d), Florida Statute, FDOT shall present the work program to the TPA "to determine the necessity of making any changes to projects included or to be included in the district work program and to hear requests for new projects to be added to, or existing projects to be deleted from, the district work program."

A. Draft 2045 Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP)

The 2045 LRTP provides a strategic 25-year outlook that leads investment and decision-making to implement the TPA's vision of a safe, efficient, and connected multimodal transportation system. The TPA must adopt a major update to the LRTP at least every five years to be eligible for Federal and State funds. B. Updates to Local Initiatives (LI) and Transportation Alternatives (TA) Program Guidelines and Scoring System

The LI and TA programs provide an annual, competitive application process to prioritize federal funds towards community identified projects that accomplish TPA goals and objectives. TPA staff will provide an overview of the programs and an update to potential changes in the upcoming application cycle.
