Transportation Disadvantaged Local Coordinating Board (LCB) Liaison Report February 12, 2020

1. **Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) 2045 Update:** The Palm Beach TPA Governing Board adopted the LRTP 2045 update on December 12, 2019. The full LRTP can be viewed at PalmBeachTPA.org/LRTP.
2. **Palm Tran Route 62 Lake Worth Beach Extension:** Palm Tran Route 62 now extends to Lake Worth Beach and Kruesler Park seven (7) days a week. For more information, visit PalmTran.org.
3. **Transportation Disadvantaged (TD) Day:** The TPA joined Palm Tran and the Board of County Commissioners on February 4, 2020 for a proclamation declaring February 11, 2020 as TD Day.
4. **Vision Zero Workshop:** The TPA held a Vision Zero Workshop on December 13, 2019 to educate, encourage, and collaborate with local governments and partner agencies on how to advance safety for all roadway users.
