1. **February TPA Governing Board Meeting:** The next TPA Governing Board Meeting will be held on Thursday, February 20 at 9:00 a.m. at the TPA Office, 301 Datura Street, West Palm Beach, FL 33401.
2. **Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) 2045 Update:** The TPA Governing Board adopted the LRTP 2045 update on December 12, 2019. The full LRTP can be viewed at PalmBeachTPA.org/LRTP.
3. **Vision Zero Workshop:** The TPA held a Vision Zero Workshop on December 13, 2019 to educate, encourage, and collaborate with local governments and partner agencies on how to advance safety for all roadway users.
