






Effective **July 1, 2019**, motorists may be stopped and cited by a law enforcement officer in Florida for texting and driving.

Additionally, effective **October 1, 2019**, wireless communications devices can only be used in a hands-free manner when driving in a designated school crossing, school zone, or active work zone area in Florida.

FLASHING YELLOW ARROW SIGNAL

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

Palm Beach County will be activating **Flashing Yellow Arrow (FYA)** left turn traffic signals at eight traffic signalized intersections along and in the vicinity of Congress Avenue between Golf Road and Gateway Boulevard. Although the FYA traffic signal has been used nationwide for over 10 years, including in over 100 locations in Florida, the FYA traffic signal is new to Palm Beach County.

WHAT IS FLASHING YELLOW ARROW?

A new traffic signal that means you can turn left if there is a safe gap in traffic

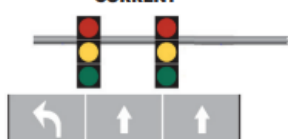

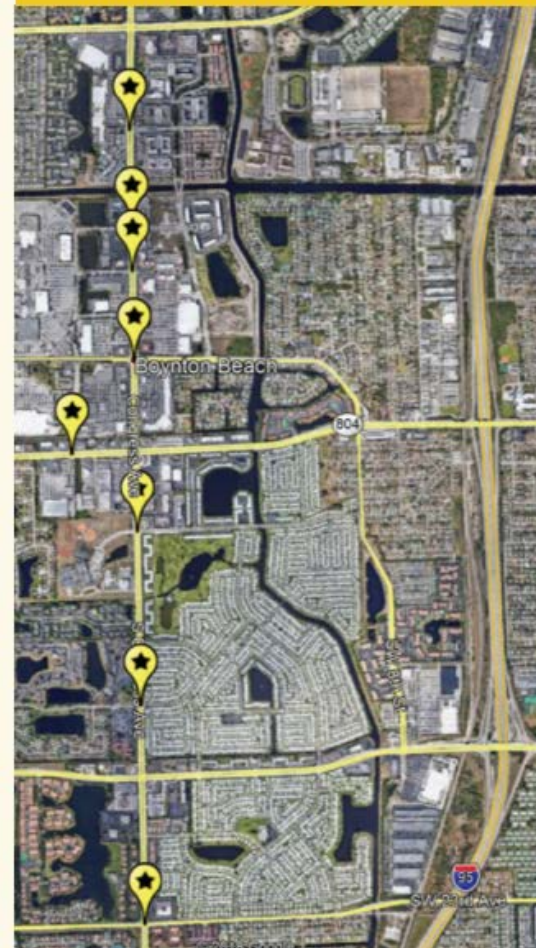
Where is the first phase of the FYA left turn signal going to be installed?

East/West Roadway	North/South Roadway

The FYA signal indication will replace the traditional solid circular green indication for the following two left-turn signal types:

- **"Permissive Only"** where only a solid circular green indication is displayed and motorists must always yield to oncoming traffic and pedestrians before completing the left turn.
- **"Protected/Permissive"** which is comprised of two parts, a "protected" left-turn phase initiated by a green arrow signal indication where oncoming traffic must stop and it is safe to turn left, followed by a "permissive" part during which a solid circular green signal is displayed and left turning traffic must yield to oncoming traffic.
