Executive Director's Report - July 16, 2020

1. **General Planning Consultant Services Request for Proposals (RFP):** The TPA is seeking two General Planning Consultant teams to assist in the advancement of our mission, vision and priorities. Submittals are due to the TPA by July 20, 2020 at 4:00 p.m., and contracts with the selected teams will be presented to the TPA Board in September. 2. **I-95 at Woolbright Road in Boynton Beach:** FDOT will host a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study Online Alternatives Public Workshop on July 22 at 5:00 p.m. To participate, visit bit.ly/2VfYiOR. For more information, visit fdot.gov/projects/95atWoolbright.
3. **SR A1A/Haven Ashe Bridge Maintenance Project in Boca Raton:** FDOT will hold a Virtual Public Meeting on July 23 with a presentation beginning at 5:00 p.m. To participate, visit fdot.cc/SRA1A-Bridge-Painting-Public-Meeting. Project construction is set to begin August 1 and will result in a full closure for up to 60 days. Vehicular traffic will be detoured while marine traffic will be maintained through the navigable waterway.
4. **Atlantic Avenue at I-95 in Delray Beach - New Lane Configuration:** A new configuration for westbound Atlantic Avenue traffic approaching I-95 began July 13. The far right westbound lane has been designated exclusively as an entrance ramp to access northbound or southbound I-95.
5. **U.S. Census 2020:** The Palm Beach County self-response rate is currently at 60%. Please continue to encourage everyone to fill out their census survey. The Census impacts federal transportation funding available to our county that is based on population size. For more information, visit 2020census.gov.
