



Executive Director's Report - June 18, 2020

1. **Boynton Beach Complete Streets and Mobility Policy:** The TPA congratulates the City of Boynton Beach for adopting a Complete Streets & Mobility Policy on June 16th with the goal of enhancing the City's multi-modal transportation network and enabling safe and comfortable access and mobility for users of all ages, abilities, income levels and transportation modes.
2. **TPA COVID-19 Travel Survey:** The TPA conducted an online survey to ask residents how COVID-19 restrictions have affected their local travel behaviors and whether those changes will become permanent as restrictions are modified.
