10. **TPA Funding Programs Applications:** Five (5) Local Initiatives (LI) project applications requesting \$18.3M in federal funds, and six (6) Transportation Alternatives (TA) applications requesting \$4.5M in federal funds were submitted. The total funds available are roughly \$20M for LI and \$3.1M for TA. In addition, ten (10) State Road Modification project requests have been compiled. Project proposals submitted are included on the following page. The final draft project lists will be included in the FY 22-26 List of Priority Projects presented for adoption in July.
