Highlights of Proposed PPP Updates

Official Form of Public Notice

- Places stronger emphasis on the TPA website as the official form of public notice

PalmBeachTPA.org

The TPA website is the official form of notification for public meeting dates and details, and for public comment opportunities including comments on TPA draft documents and plans.

Highlights of Proposed PPP Updates

L RTP and TIP Adoption Policy

What is it?

- Requires approval or rejection of entire LRTP/TIP
- Requires requests for project additions/deletions to be heard as proposed amendments at a future meeting

Why do it?

- To ensure adequate public notice for interested parties
- To provide clarity for voting members
- To maintain balance between available funds and project costs
- To allow staff review of add/delete impacts

Highlights of Proposed PPP Updates

Consistency With TPA Operating Procedures

- Acknowledges and reflects updates required for consistency with the TPA Operating Procedures first adopted April 2020
- Eliminates superseded references to individual sets of bylaws
- Includes public participation for virtual meetings when legally permitted
- Reflects the authority of the Chair to approve and/or amend certain essential documents when the TPA is unable to conduct a Board meeting in person or virtually

Highlights of Proposed PPP Updates

Public Participation Goals and Objectives

- Removes public participation goals, objectives, targets and measures from the PPP and reflects their inclusion and reporting within the TPA's Strategic Plan and annual report card
- Allows for goals, actions and outcomes to engage the public to be more specific, more frequently updated, and aligned with the TPA's Unified Planning Work Program (UPWP)
