- 2. Rate of fatalities per 100 million VMT
- 3. Number of serious injuries
- 4. Rate of serious injuries per 100 million VMT
- 5. Number of non-motorized fatalities and serious injuries

VMT = Vehicle Miles Traveled



#### Required Palm Tran Measures by Mode

- 1. Number of fatalities
- 2. Rate of fatalities per 100 thousand VRM
- 3. Number of injuries
- 4. Rate of injuries per 100 thousand VRM
- 5. Number of safety events
- 6. Safety events per 100 thousand VRM
- 7. VRM average distance between mechanical failures

VRM = Vehicle Revenue Miles

#### Previous Targets

Adopted targets of zero fatalities & serious injuries for 2018 - 2020

- FHWA: zero fatalities on our Nation's roadways is the only acceptable goal
- FDOT: Formally adopted targets of zero for 2018 2021
- Vision Zero Cities in Palm Beach County: West Palm Beach, Boynton Beach, and Palm Beach Gardens





### Impacts of COVID-19 on safety per NHTSA

- Reduction in congestion results in higher speeds
- Drivers on roadways are less risk-averse
- Decrease in seat belt use
- Increase in alcohol and drug use
- Observed increase in pedestrian and bicycle activity
