Summary Points of the June 17, 2021 Governing Board Meeting

Approved Citizens Advisory Committee (CAC) Appointment - The Board approved Cheryl Schneider as nominated by the Town of Jupiter Council Member Kuretski through June 2024.

Approved Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) Renewal - The Board renewed Michael O'Dell as Representative for the Village of Wellington through June 2024.

Approved FY 22-26 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP) - TPA staff summarized the FY 22-26 TIP which can be viewed at PalmBeachTPA.org/TIP. The Board adopted a Resolution approving the FY 22-26 TIP as presented and authorized the TPA Executive Director to:

- Approve administrative amendments to the FY 21-25 TIP during the three (3) month gap between July 1 and September 30, when FHWA and FTA still recognize the FY 21-25 TIP as being effect, so long as the project amendment is exactly as it appears in the FY 22-26 TIP;
- Approve administrative modifications (add/modify/delete) to locally funded projects in the FY 22-26 TIP to remain consistent with local decisions; and
- Approve administrative modifications to the document narrative in the FY 22-26 TIP to address errata and/or agency review comments.

Tabled a Resolution affirming TPA support for the Atlantic Avenue Project (Florida's Turnpike to Jog Road) with requested modifications - The Board tabled this item and directed TPA and FDOT staff to prepare and present alternative typical sections that provide a physical barrier between vehicle lanes and bicycle lanes to address safety concerns for cyclists and promote bicycling by community members of all ages and abilities.

Smart Growth America (SGA) Champions Institute - Council Member Thomson provided an update on his experience in the 2020 Institute. The Active People, Healthy Nation Champions Institute is a new SGA initiative to prepare elected officials to effectively advocate for and support safer and more Complete Streets. Over the course of six months, leaders receive comprehensive training to help them become champions in their communities to promote activity-friendly routes to everyday destinations.

Draft Mobility Vision Project Map - TPA staff reviewed the major components of the Draft Mobility Vision Project Map, including the 561 Plan Transit corridors, connecting Tier 1 ped/bike investment corridors; County road widening projects, traffic signal investments, and municipal mobility services.

Okeechobee Boulevard & SR 7 Study Kick-Off - TPA staff provided an update on the Okeechobee Boulevard & SR 7 Multimodal Corridor Study, one of the 561 Plan Transit corridors, including an overview of the project timeline and ways to get involved.
