Program Purpose	Advance safety, complete streets, transit and other modifications to state roadways	Advance safety, complete streets, and other local initiatives on county and city roadways	Fund safe and connected infrastructure for non-motorized users
Eligible Projects	Complete streets, traffic calming, intersection modifications	Complete streets, transit capital, freight efficiency	Pedestrian and bicycle facilities, Safe Routes to School infrastructure
Available Funding	\$20.4M	\$20M	\$3.1M
Min/Max Funding	\$500K / \$5M	\$250K / \$5M	\$250K / \$1M
Construction Timing	Year 7 (Stand-Alone Only)	Year 5	Year 3



Project Scoring Highlights

LI & TA Programs

- Adds shared use path as bike facility
- Removes length cap on facility scoring
- Replaces Income and Underserved Population Index with New Traditionally Underserved Population Index

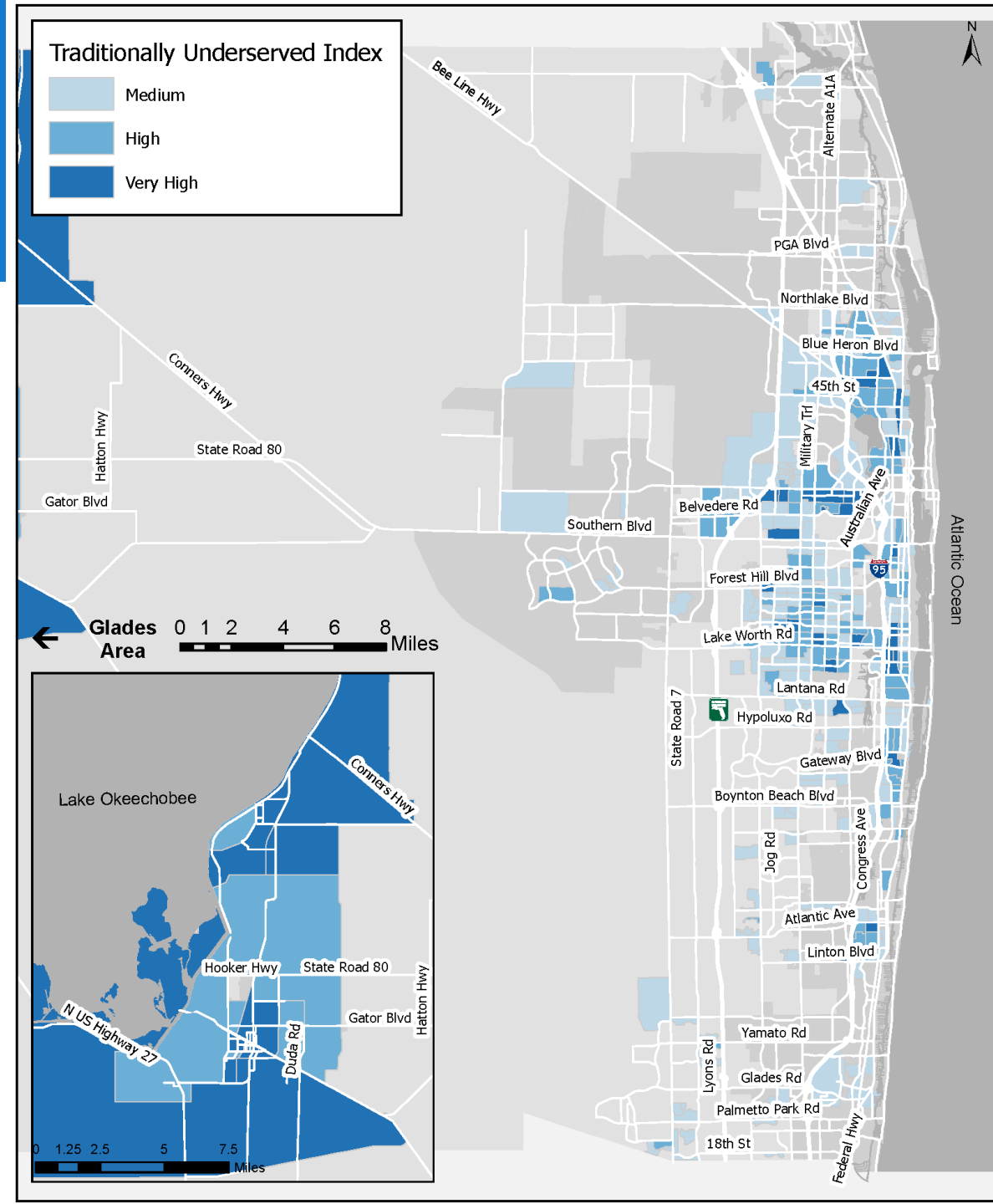
SRM Program

- Mimics LI Scoring
- Adds points for defining target speed, including safety countermeasures, and modifying existing maintenance project (vs. new project)

New Traditionally Underserved Index

- Racial Minority x 1.5
- + Ethnic Minority x 1.5
- + Below Poverty x 1.5
- + Limited English Proficiency (LEP)
- + Persons with Disabilities
- + Elderly (65+)
- + Youth (5-21)
- + Zero-Vehicle Households
- + Low Education Attainment (Less Than HS Diploma)

= **Traditionally Underserved Index Score**
