# FULL CLOSURES THRU SEPTEMBER

### I-95 SB Entrance Ramp from WB Indiantown Road

This 0.5-mile project began July 27, 2016, and is expected to be completed in early fall 2016, weather permitting.

The construction cost is an estimated \$647,603.95.

Work is being performed by Jones Benitez Corporation, with the Florida Department of Transportation overseeing the project.

**F**ull closures of the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from westbound Indiantown Road, in the Town of Jupiter, are expected through September 2016 for minor widening and the placement of a high-friction epoxy overlay surface.

**Ramp Closure & Detour:** The ramp may be closed nightly, from 9 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday night through Friday morning, weather permitting. Motorists may detour by heading westbound on Indiantown Road past the ramp, making a U-turn on Indiantown Road at the Turnpike Plaza, and accessing the I-95 southbound entrance ramp from eastbound Indiantown Road.

Please note, when full ramp closures are not needed, one lane of the ramp may be closed, Tuesday night through Friday morning. Advanced warning signs will be in place to detour motorists during the full closures.
