The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four, will host a Construction Open House for the lighting improvements project at the I-95 interchange at PGA Boulevard in the City of Palm Beach Gardens.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

 Replace six (6) of the existing high mast light poles with a new LED lighting system at the I-95 interchange at PGA Boulevard in the City of Palm Beach Gardens.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS

- Lanes closures are permitted between 10 p.m. and 5 a.m.,
 Sunday night through Thursday night.
- Work will be done in four (4) phases. Simultaneous ramp closures are not permitted. Therefore, only one ramp may have lane closures at any given time.
- Should a full ramp closure be needed overnight, two weeks advanced noticed will be provided to the public along with detour information.


