I-95 Lighting and Roadway Improvements Project

From south of the State Road (SR) 706/Indiantown Road Interchange to the County Road (CR) 708/SE Bridge Road Interchange

I-95 SB from SE Bridge Road to Indiantown Road to Undergo Overnight Full Closures Feb. 27 - Mar. 3

I-95 southbound from County Road 708/SE Bridge Road to State Road 706/Indiantown Road may be closed nightly, Sunday, Feb. 27 through Thursday night, Mar. 3, from 11:30 p.m. until 4:30 a.m., weather permitting, for overhead sign structure installation. If needed, this full closure may also occur Sunday, Mar. 6 through Thursday night, Mar. 10, from 11:30 p.m. to 4:30 a.m. Motorists will be detoured via Federal Highway and Indiantown Road.

This work is part of the I-95 lighting and roadway improvements project from south of the SR 706/Indiantown Road interchange to the CR 708/SE Bridge Road interchange in Jupiter and Hobe Sound. Work on this project includes: installing new roadway lighting with LED luminaries, replacing the high mast lighting system with a conventional LED roadway lighting system, extending the northbound I-95 merge lane just north of Indiantown Road, extending the deceleration distances for the I-95 northbound to westbound Indiantown Road exit ramp and the I-95 southbound to eastbound Indiantown Road exit ramp, and installing wrong way vehicle detection systems at the Indiantown Road and SE Bridge Road I-95 interchanges and new advanced warning signage.
