



**Brightline Construction Advisory
Lane Closure and Work Zone Updates for Orlando Extension
(Phase 2 - South Florida to Orlando)**

ORLANDO, FL. (May 10, 2021) – Brightline announces lane closures, work zone, railroad crossing and bridge work information for Phase 2 construction from Orlando to West Palm Beach, connecting Orlando to South Florida. Motorists and watercraft should proceed with extra caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs, speed limits and other signage. **Full closures and high-profile closures are indicated in red.** Railroad construction information can also be found online at <https://www.gobrightline.com/railroad-construction>.

Orange County

Orlando International Airport

Eastbound and westbound Cargo Rd. between Bear Rd. and Casa Verde Rd. (north of Orlando International Airport)

Extended single lane closure in each direction through Fall 2021 for bridge work. One lane will remain open in each direction.

Beachline Expressway/SR 528 at Narcoossee Rd.

Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 exit ramp to Narcoossee Rd. (Exit 13)

Extended single lane closure on exit ramp through 2021 for bridge work.

Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 exit ramp to Narcoossee Rd. (Exit 13)

Continuous day-time shoulder closure, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m.

Narcoossee Rd. entrance ramp to Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528

Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 entrance ramp to southbound SR 417

Southbound SR 417 at Beachline Expressway/SR 528

Full road closure, 10 p.m., Monday, May 10 to 6 a.m., Tuesday, May 11 for bridge work.

Detour Information:

- Southbound SR 417 traffic will be directed to exit at westbound SR 528 (Exit 26), travel west to SR 15/Narcoossee Rd. (Exit 13), travel south on SR 15/Narcoossee Rd. to Dowden Rd. and travel east on Dowden Rd. to access SR 417.

Brevard County

Beachline Expressway/SR 528

Eastbound Beachline Expressway/SR 528 (milepost 34-40)

Railroad Crossings

Melbourne – Railroad Crossing at Prospect Ave. (LONGTERM CLOSURE)

Full road closure through May 2022 for bridge work at Crane Creek. *Crossing will be fully closed until completion of work.*

Detour Information:

- Eastbound Prospect Ave. traffic will be directed to Stone St., travel south on Stone St. to WH Jackson St., travel east on WH Jackson St. to US-1 and travel north on US-1 to access Prospect Ave.
- Westbound Prospect Ave. traffic will be directed to US-1, travel south on US-1 to WH Jackson St., travel west on WH Jackson St. to Stone St. and travel north on Stone St. to access Prospect Ave.

Bridges

Melbourne – Eau Gallie River

Day-time pile driving operations, Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2022 to install temporary work trestle (platforms) for cranes on the west side of the existing active railroad bridge (southwest bank) and for bridge construction.

Melbourne – Crane Creek

Day-time bridge work operations, including pile driving, Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q2 2022 to construct a railroad bridge on the east side of the existing bridge.

Palm Bay – Turkey Creek

Day-time bridge work operations, including crane mobilization, Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2022 to install a temporary work trestle (platforms) for cranes on the east side of the existing active railroad bridge (northeast bank) and for bridge construction.

Malabar / Grant-Valkaria – Goat Creek

Day-time bridge work operations, Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through 2021 to construct a railroad bridge on the west side of the existing bridge.

Day-time bridge work operations, Monday through Saturday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., through Q3 2021 to construct a railroad bridge on the east side of the existing bridge.

Jensen Beach – NE Dixie Hwy.

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for rail work. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit NE Dixie Hwy.*

Stuart – Railroad Crossing at NW Alice St.

Full road closure, 7 a.m., Monday, May 10 to 6 p.m., Wednesday, May 19.

- Eastbound NW Alice St. traffic will be directed to travel south on NW Dixie Hwy. to Fern St., travel east on Fern St. to Flagler Ave. and travel north on Flagler Ave. to access NW Alice St.
- Westbound NW Alice St. traffic will be directed to travel south on Flagler Ave. to Fern St., travel west on Fern St. to NW Dixie Hwy. and travel north on NW Dixie Hwy. to access NW Alice St.

Stuart – NW Alice St.

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for rail work. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit NW Alice St.*

Stuart – NW Fern St.

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. for rail work. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit NW Fern St.*

Stuart – Southbound A1A from south of SE Cove Rd. to south of SE Alicia St.

Continuous shoulder closure through May 2021.

Jupiter – Riverside Dr. and Alternate A1A

Day-time flagging operations, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. to move materials for bridge construction, continuing through May 2021. *Crossings may be closed briefly (1-2 minutes) as trucks enter and exit the right of way.*

Stuart – Rio Waterway

Day-time bridge work operations, including crane mobilization and pile driving operations, Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2021 to install temporary work trestles (platforms) for cranes as well as demolition and construction of railroad bridge on the west side of the existing active railroad bridge (southwest bank).

Port Salerno – Manatee Waterway South

Day-time bridge work operations, including crane mobilization, demolition and pile driving, Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q4 2021.

Port Salerno – Salerno Waterway North

Day-time bridge work operations, including crane mobilization, demolition and pile driving, Monday to Friday, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., continuing through Q3 2021.

Palm Beach County

Railroad Crossings / Lane Closures.

Palm Beach Gardens – Railroad Crossing at Kyoto Gardens Dr.

Bridges

Jupiter – Loxahatchee River

Day-time pile driving operations, 7 a.m. to 7 p.m., Monday through Sunday, continuing through October 2021 to install temporary work trestles (platforms) for cranes on the east and west sides of the existing bridge (north bank).
