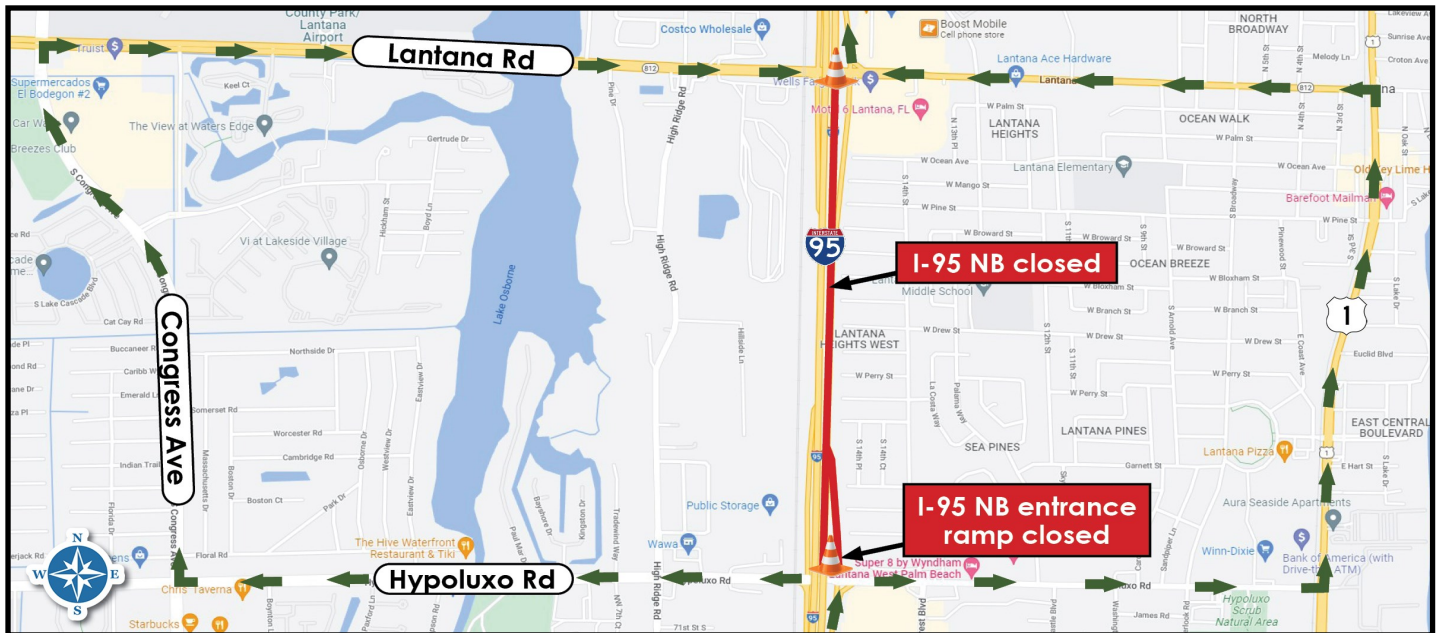
SR/9 I-95 Milling and Resurfacing

I-95 from north of Gateway Boulevard to Lantana Road

I-95 Northbound at Hypoluxo Rd. To Be Closed Overnight April 5

I-95 northbound at Hypoluxo Road will be closed to traffic overnight, 9:30 p.m. until 6 a.m., Tuesday, April 5 for Traffic Monitoring Site loop installation. Two lanes of I-95 will be closed at 9:30 p.m., three lanes will be closed at 10 p.m., and all lanes will be closed at 1 a.m. Motorists traveling on I-95 will be detoured via the Hypoluxo Road exit ramp, northbound US-1, and westbound Lantana Road to the I-95 northbound entrance ramp. FHP will be onsite to assist motorists. In association with activity, the I-95 northbound entrance ramp from Hypoluxo Road will also be closed to traffic overnight, Tuesday, April 5, 9:30 p.m. until 5 a.m. Motorists will be detoured via westbound Hypoluxo Road, northbound Congress Avenue, and eastbound Lantana Road to the I-95 northbound entrance ramp. Signage will be in place to assist motorists. Wednesday night, April 6 will be used as a contingency if needed.



Project improvements include milling and resurfacing of I-95 in both directions as well as the entrance and exit ramps at Hypoluxo Road and Lantana Road. Wrong Way Driving Detection Systems and median lighting upgrades are also included in the scope of work.
