The City of Delray Beach, as Project Sponsor, requested that the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District Four design and construct the George Bush Boulevard Improvements Project, through application to the Palm Beach Transportation Planning Agency and City of Delray Beach Resolution 06-18. DETOUR FOR DRAINAGE INSTALLATION BETWEEN NE 8TH AVENUE AND PALM TRAIL THROUGH MARCH 21, 2022

- **Beginning Monday, Mar. 7, 2022 George Bush Boulevard, between NE 8th Avenue and Palm Trail, will undergo a full closure for drainage installation through Monday, Mar. 21, 2022**
- Detour routes are marked along George Bush Boulevard, NE 8th Avenue, NE 6th Street, and Palm Trail as noted on the detour map provided
- Please note, work activities are being performed during daytime hours, Monday through Saturday:
 - Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. - 6:00 p.m.
 - Saturday, 8:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m.
- During this time, the City of Delray Beach is also performing utility repairs in this location
- Emergency vehicle, local driveway and pedestrian access is being provided at all times

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

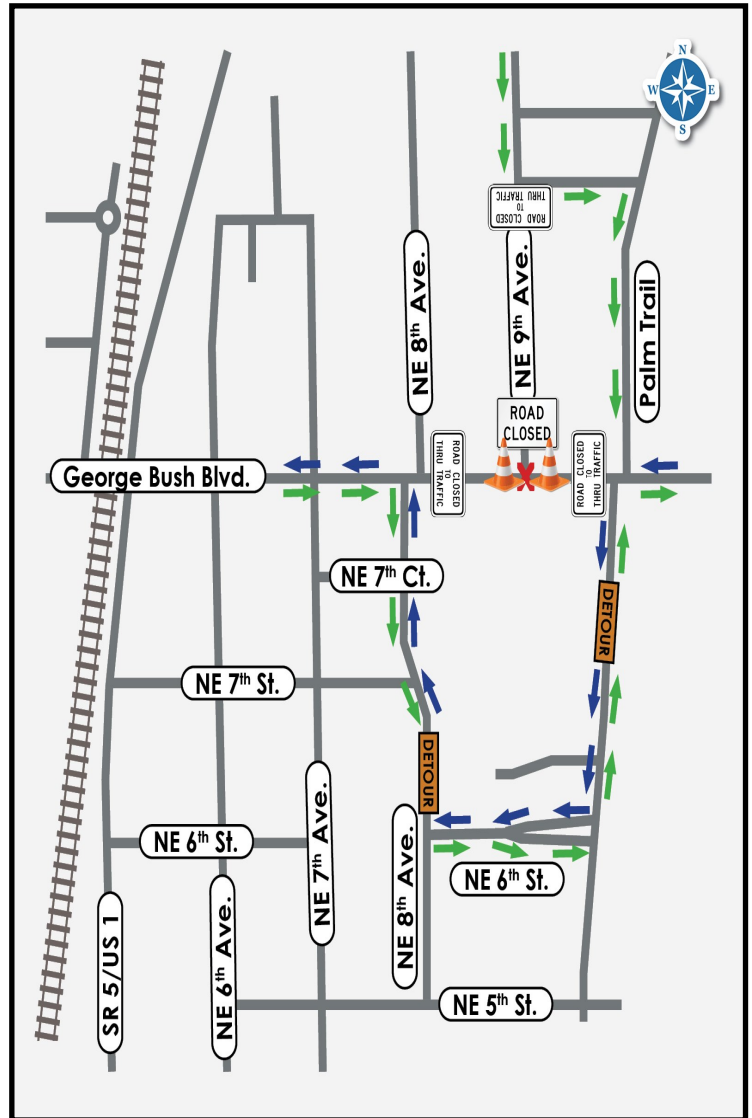
- Milling and resurfacing the roadway with minor widening; drainage and utility improvements
- Concrete sidewalk and driveway replacement, new sidewalk connections, and curb and gutter improvements
- Signing and pavement marking upgrades, including bike lane and detectable warning surfaces
